SCOPE OF WORK

Business/firm to be Hazwoper certified, and OSHA compliant and licensed to treat/clean up Ebola in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania as required (If not so required, then licensed to treat/clean up Ebola in at least one (1) other jurisdiction):

- Voluntary cleanup operations and/or cleanup operations required by any applicable governmental body (federal, state, local or other) involving hazardous substances) with regard to Ebola;
- Emergency response operations for releases of, or substantial threats of release of, hazardous substances (regardless of the hazard's location) with regard to Ebola.

The most commonly used manual for HAZWOPER activities is *Department of Health and Human Services Publication 85-115, Occupational Safety and Health Guidance Manual for Hazardous Waste Site Activities*. Written for government contractors and first responders, the manual lists safety requirement for cleanups and emergency-response operations
