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## September 8, 2016 Property Survey Services for Single Family Units in Manchester Rebid 3 Quote Bid

## ADDENDUM NO.1

This addendum issued September 8, 2016 becomes in its entirety a part of the 3 Quote Bid as is fully set forth herein:

- Item 1: Q. In looking at the HACP website, it appears that this project was originally bid in August. What is the reason for the project being rebid?
  - **A.** The HACP only received one bid.
- **Item 2:** Q. The Quote Request indicates an American Land Title Association survey is request, are we correct in assuming the intent is to perform an ALTA/NSPS Land Title Survey for each property?
  - A. Yes.
- **Item 3:** Q. Assuming the request is for an ALTA/NSPS Land Title Survey, what are the option Table A requirements for the surveys?
  - A. No Table A options are required at this time.
- **Item 4:** Q: Can you provide more details on what item 11 and 12 (page 2 of the Quote Request) may include?
  - A: None.
- **Item 5: Q:** The Quote Request notes that Davis-Bacon and minimum wage requirements may apply. Is this a prevailing wage project? And if so, can you please provide the applicable rate schedule?
  - A: No.
- **Item 6:** Page 3 of the Quote Request include a bid sheet, with the terms "Individual Appraisal Cost," is this intended to be the cost per survey?
  - A: Any reference to "Appraisal" services should be deleted from the Property Survey Services for Single Family Units in Manchester Rebid 3 Quote Bid.

Item 7: Q: What is the requested schedule or timeline for the completion of surveys? Is there a deadline for completion?

A: Yes, from the issuance of a Notice to Proceed to the successful bidder.

Item 8: Q: Have the title commitments for these properties been completed, if not when will they be ready for use by the successful bidder?

A: Yes, the title commitments for these properties been completed and will be ready for use by the successful bidder.

**Item 9: Q:** Will HACP take care of notifying the subject properties and adjourning properties of the survey activities to insure access to the premises, including those not owned by HACP?

A: Yes.

Item 10: Q: What electronic format is requested for the final plan submission?

A: PDF
