Congratulations! You have been selected for The Housing Authority of the City Of Pittsburgh Resident Employment Program. HACP has entered into an agreement with Rogers School of Driving. Rogers will provide behind the wheel education to residents of public housing. You will have 6 months to complete to complete the program.

How to Qualify

- All candidates must possess a current valid Pennsylvania driver's permit to enter driver's training program.
- All driving students must be a resident in the Housing Authority City of Public Housing, Section 8 or Scattered site.
- Must be a participant of the Family Self Sufficiency (FSS)/ Resident Employment Program (REP) and assigned to a Service Coordinator.
- All candidates must show the proper identification to prove 19yrs of age and older.

Driver's License Education Rules

- Students must have their drivers permit on them while operating the vehicle.
- Students must be at the arranged site for the instructor to pick up.
- Students are permitted to receive 8/two hours on the road trips and 1/ one hour examination road test.
- There are **NO** additional lessons provided by the instructor or Housing Authority of Pittsburgh.
- The driver candidate <u>MUST</u> contact instructor if he or she cannot keep the lesson for the day. There will be a fee when you complete a no call no show! Fee will be determined by Rogers School of driving and must be paid in order to receive lessons.
- Only the student is permitted in the car with instructor.
- Student must demonstrate a positive attitude to remain in the Driver Education Training Program.
