Health & Safety Essentials
Smoke Detectors Installed in each bedroom and on each floor Working properly (test it; it should beep when pressed)
Carbon Monoxide Detectors (if applicable) Required if you have fuel-burning appliances or an attached garage
Fire Exits No blocked windows or doors All exit paths are clear and usable
Electrical Safety
Outlets & Switches Covers are not broken or missing No exposed wires Outlets work and are not scorched or loose
Light Fixtures Bulbs work No loose or hanging wires
Plumbing & Water
Running Water All sinks, tubs, and toilets have running water No constant leaks or drips
Hot Water Water gets hot in kitchen and bathroom
Toilet ☐ Flushes properly, no overflow
Mold/Mildew

☐ No visible mold growth (especially in bathroom/kitchen)
Heating, Cooling & Ventilation
Heating System Works during colder months
Cooling (if provided) Air conditioning is working
Windows & Vents Open and close properly No blocked vents
Cleanliness & Infestation
Pests No roaches, rodents, or bed bugs
Cleanliness ☐ Garbage is taken out regularly ☐ No excessive clutter that could block exits or cause hazards
Structure & Security
Doors Lock and latch properly No holes or damage
Windows Not broken Lockable and weatherproof
Floors & Ceilings No tripping hazards No major holes or soft spots

Before the Inspector Arrives:

Know your inspection date

Be present if possible

Do a quick clean-up and walkthrough

Report any problems in writing to management before and after the inspection
